Advent has begun

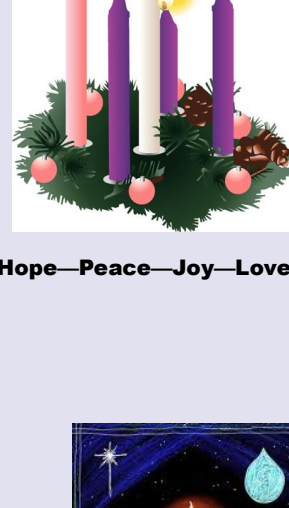

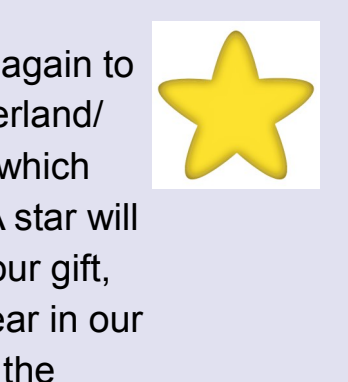
Longest Night Service

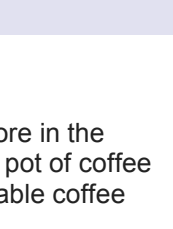


Trustees

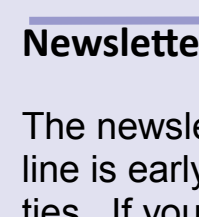
